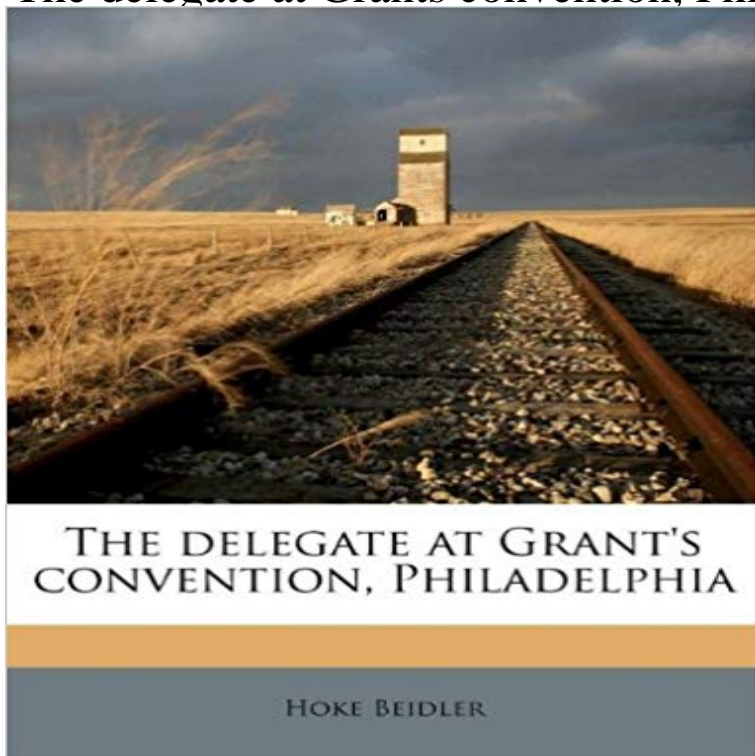


The delegate at Grants convention, Philadelphia
