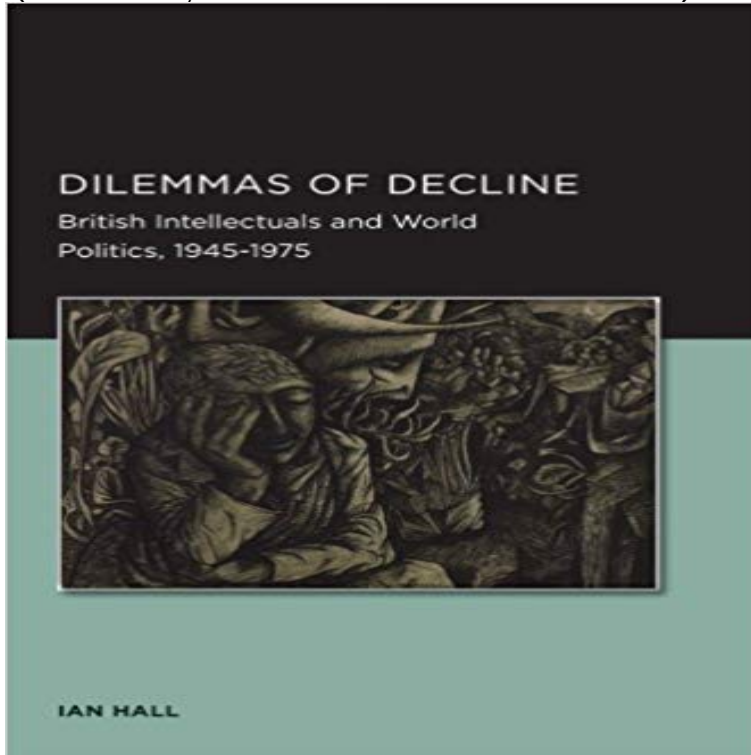


## Dilemmas of Decline: British Intellectuals and World Politics, 1945-1975 (Berkeley Series in British Studies)

Amid this turmoil, British intellectuals struggled to make sense of their country's decline and the transformed world in which they found themselves. This book assesses their responses to this predicament and explores the different ways British thinkers came to understand the new international relations of the postwar period.
