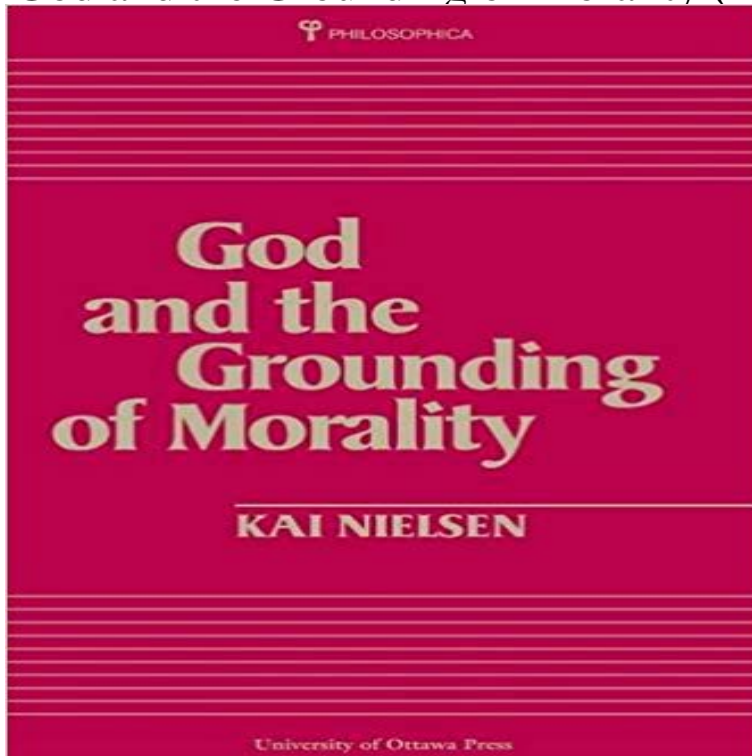


God and the Grounding of Morality (Philosophica)
